He expressed his deep concern at the increasing number of violent clashes in and around the Temple Mount in East Jerusalem, and the need everything to be done to alleviate the situation.-----

He scored the attachment of France to full respect of the Holy Places.-----These events illustrate once again the importance of a rapid resumption of talks to progress towards a resolution of the conflict. This is the meaning of the new international support of the peace process which France proposed the establishment, to promote the creation of an independent Palestinian state, viable and sovereign, living in peace and security alongside Israel ."
